General

Alstroemeria commonly called Inca Lily or Peruvian Lily belong to the family of the Alstroemeriaceae and originate from South-America, the family contains about 50 species.


Alstroemeria is a long day plant, flowering is induced by cool nights and the variety does not handle warm climates.

The optimal temperatures are between 15-20°C during the day and 5-10°C at night. Soil temperatures around 15°C are ideal to achieve maximum production, if exceeding 20°C production is reduced.

The flowers can handle rain. Both overhead and drip irrigation are ideal. Its leaves are resupinate; they twist from the base so that what appears to be the upper leaf surface is in fact the lower leaf surface
